

ROAD CLOSURES

Middleton Road

Closed to all traffic (including permit holders) from Heywood Old Road to Sheepfoot Lane in both directions. 19:00 - 02:00 10th & 11th June.

2 M60 Junction 19

Junction 19 of the M60 all exits and entrances will be closed on **Saturday 10th and Sunday 11th June from 19:00 - 02:00** except for the anticlockwise slip road onto the M60.

3 Middleton Road

Closed from the Jct. of Victoria Avenue to Crumpsall Lane in both directions. **20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.**

4 Sheepfoot Lane

Dynamic closure may be required both Eastbound & Westbound from the Jct. of Bury Old Road to Middleton Road. 10:00 - 16:00 9th, 10th & 11th June to maintain pedestrian safety.

5 Sheepfoot Lane

Closed from the Jct. of Bury Old Road to Middleton Road in both directions. 20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.

6 Blackley New Road

Closed from the Jct. of Riverdale Road to Middleton Road in both directions. 20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.

7 Meade Hill Road

Closed from the Jct. of Middleton Road to Sheepfoot Lane in both directions. **20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.**

8 Bury Old Road

Closed from the Jct. of Scholes Lane/Sheepfoot Lane to the Jct. of Whittaker Lane in both directions. 20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.

NB: During road closures, residential access will only be whilst safe to do so. At times, roads will be closed to ALL TRAFFIC including permit holders, to assist in the safe and timely dispersal of the audience.

ONE WAY SYSTEMS

9 Whittaker Lane

Open to Westbound traffic only from the Jct. of Bury Old Road to the Jct. of Heywood Road. **20:00 - 01:00 9th, 10th & 11th June.** All traffic must follow the direction of the one way.

10 Victoria Avenue

Open to Westbound traffic only from the Jct. of Tweedle Hill Road to the Jct. of Middleton Road. 19:00 - 02:00 10th & 11th June.

NON EVENT TRAFFIC SHOULD USE ALTERNATIVE ROUTE.

This is in place to assist with vehicle movement whist maintaining pedestrian safety. Residents within this area wishing to leave during these times should do so via Heaton Park Road where a managed crossing system will be in place across to Broomhall Road.

CLEANSING

Ideal Cleansing is our dedicated external cleansing team. Their responsibility during Parklife is litter clearance in the areas surrounding the park including the roads and pavements in the vicinity.

There are dedicated jet washing teams in operation and additional bins are located around the exterior of the park. Portable toilets are deployed over the exterior of the event site.

NB: In addition to litter picking, road sweeping will take place overnight on the 9th, 10th & 11th June.
